BASIC EQUIPMENT NEEDED TO GET STARTED

- A shoka style container, wider at the top than the bottom
- Good quality floral shears (hasimi)
- Good quality kenzan (pin frog) at least 8cm
- Plastic for covering the workspace
- Flower bucket tall enough to hold material and transport arrangements
- Joy of Ikenobo book (optional but highly recommended)
- Small plastic container (eg medium sized margarine tub) to transport flower arrangement
